Requirements

To apply for our master's programme

- ✓ you are required to hold a Bachelor's degree or equivalent, from an institution of higher education, with good or excellent merits
- ✓ degree must be equivalent to at least three years of full-time studies (180 ECTS)
- degree is in Software Engineering, Information Systems, Computer Science, Information Technology, Computer Engineering or nearby studies (enough studies on the field).
- Minimum English language requirements (test needed):
 - \checkmark TOEFL PBT580, iBT 92 or IELTS 6,5

Acceptance rate about 30%, depending on year



Application period: 15 December 2015 - 30 January 2016


We asked what our students want to tell you about studying in Oulu and Finland



Is it cold living in Oulu?

- Four distinct seasons (Summer, Fall, Winter, Spring)
- Sometimes -10 -- -25 C in winter; more commonly around -0 -- -10 C (and snow, of course)
- Central heating system and triple glasses in windows keep the temperature convenient inside
- Air conditioning system increasingly in houses for cooling in summer
- In summer time about +15 -- +30
- Midnight sun in late June



University of Oulu: ECTS accreditation in 2013

- European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System, ECTS
- Awarded by the European Commission
- Awarded to the top 2% of European universities
- University of Oulu is the first university in Finland to achieve the accreditation


